- I. Approval of Financial Reports

- II. WACCT Education Committee Report

- a. WACCT Fall Conference Members of the Board commented on how it was advantageous to have the annual WACCT Conference adjacent to the Joint Education Committee meeting. It allowed the Community College to bring in speakers who could contribute to the WACCT Conference, but also provide information to the Joint Education Committee. It also allowed a lot of community college supporters to attend the legislative meeting. It is something WACCT should consider for next year's conference.
- b. February trustee education event Ideas for the trustee education day were discussed and the ED was given direction to pursue the pathways idea as presented by Dr. Schaffer and Dr. Hicswa (informally to the ED).
- c. Statewide marketing The ED reported that the trustee education video is still being produced by Wyoming Public TV and they asked for an extension in the final delivery of the video.
- d. WACCT Awards Walt Wragge, Chairman of the TLC, reported that the TLC is not ready to move forward with a change to the 'Transforming Lives' idea. Therefore, nomination packets for the WACCT Awards will go out immediately.
