## **What We're Supporting for the 2023 General Legislative Session**

Wyoming's community colleges are the heart of our state. If they are to continue to be what drives our economy forward, they need comprehensive support.

### **APPROPRIATELY FUND the State's Community Colleges**

- Funding for talent recruitment and retention
- Support budget requests
- Revisit recommendations made in the WCCC Sustainable Funding Workgroup Report Recs & Legislative Select Committee on Community College Funding and Governance

### **INSTITUTE the Community College Statutory Funding Model**

- Restore levels of construction
- Include an external cost adjustment
- Include some consideration for headcount + FTE in the four-year recalibration process

### **SUPPORT the Community College Role in Fulfilling the State's Economic Strategic Plan**

through Wyoming's Innovation Partnership

### **FULLY FUND the Wyoming's Tomorrow Scholarship (HB 30)**

- Allow matching funds from private donors
- Consider additional legislative appropriations

### **Wyoming Works for Tomorrow (HB 109)**

- Align programs that aim to meet Wyoming's workforce needs and invest in the state's adult learners
- Allow for charitable contributions from business and private foundations

### **ENDORSE Capital Construction Projects that Support the CC Mission**

- Increase project authorization dollars
- Support the annually ranked projects from the WCCC and State Building Commission
- Consider additional contingency appropriation for current projects (due to inflation)
- Fully fund major maintenance at 2.56%
