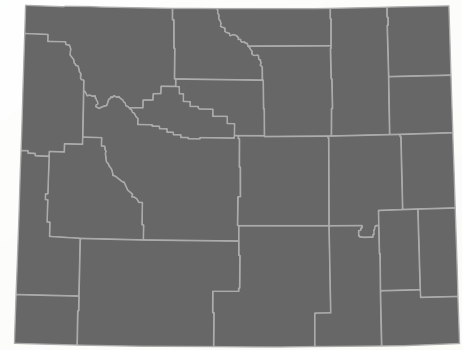

### Alumni impact

Enough to buy **1,456** families\* a year's worth of groceries

*Impact of expenditures for ongoing construction projects*

OR **158** Jobs supported

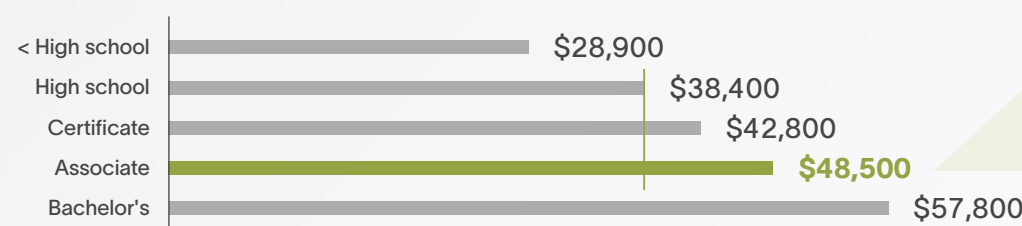

### Average earnings by education level at career midpoint

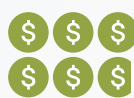


The average associate degree graduate from Wyoming Community Colleges will see an increase in earnings of **\$10,100** each year compared to someone with a high school diploma working in Wyoming.

For every **\$1...**



Students gain **\$5.80** in lifetime earnings



Society gains **\$4.50** in added income and social savings
